Job Overview

- Based in Aberdeen, the role is to manage a new controls product line being developed by Interventek. The critical responsibilities will be the ongoing design, development, testing and qualification of the technology. Additionally, the product line manager will be responsible for the commercialisation of the system in cooperation with the Interventek valve design team.
- The control system is being developed to complement Interventek's market leading shear and seal Revolution valve technology that is deployed on in-riser and open-water intervention systems. The system is designed to be a more compact, lightweight solution than existing systems.
- The Product Line Manager will report to the Technical Director.

Essential Qualifications / Experience / Skills Required

- Experience with managing projects.
- Knowledge of hydraulic control systems.
- Knowledge of electrical control systems.
- Knowledge of fibre optical communications. (Not essential but desirable).
- Subsea intervention operations experience. (Not essential but desirable).
- Willingness to explore technology outwith the oil and gas sector.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Continue to drive development of the compact electro/hydraulic control system, incorporating new technology, as well as improvements to existing products.
- Lead a small team of engineers providing clear performance targets and expectations. Provide mentoring and guidance as required.
- Responsible for the product life cycle from completion of design through commercialisation, operational support and continuous improvement of the product line.
- Responsible for all aspects of QHSE and compliance as it relates to the product line which includes developing and implementing product testing, qualification, procedures and training manuals.
- Responsible for managing the product line budget and forecasts.
- Manage the supply chain, which will include negotiating technical and commercial agreements.
- Ability to communicate with customers to ensure that the product line meets or exceeds customer expectations
- Liaise with sales and marketing to promote the technology.
- Ability to collaborate effectively with other departments within Interventek.
